Motion to Amend Agenda to consider Progressive Energy Consultants recommended contract with Snyder Brothers Inc. Reason for amendment is to realize a savings to the Borough's current natural gas costs. Snyder Brothers, Inc., offers natural gas supply for a periods of 24 months at .435/ccf or 36 months at .416/ccf. Copies of Snyder's 24 and 36 month contracts have been furnished to Council members by the Borough Secretary for their consideration. National Fuel Gas Company's (NFG) current price for natural gas is \$0.6211ccf. Further, NFG rates are subject to quarterly changes in February, May, August and November. NFG gas pricing follows the Chicago Mercantile Exchange (CME) which trades in commodity futures such as in crude oil, natural gas, etc.. CME natural gas prices go up or down depending upon market forces. Snyder Brothers', Inc., 2 and 3 year proposals offer more certainty for Borough's budgeted amount for natural gas costs and lower the risks of natural gas prices exceeding the amount budgeted.
