Call to Order: The West Middlesex Borough Council Meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by the Borough Council President, Mr. Tim Webster

Pledge of Allegiance

Mr. Tim Webster read the Pledge of Public Comments.

An Executive Session held on June 16, 2026 at 5:00 pm for Personnel: Interviews were conducted for the Part Time Laborer Position.

Council Present: President: Mr. Tim Webster conducted the meeting, Vice-President: Mr. Dennis Bollinger, Mr. Robert Rankin, Mrs. Cristal Bollinger, Mr. Keiuffer Ritter, Mayor Stacey Curry.

Minutes: A motion was made by Mr. Ritter to Accept the Minutes of May 6, 2026 Work Session Meeting, and May 12, 2026 Council Meeting, Seconded by Mr. Rankin, All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.

Police Report: Chief Gatewood read the Police Report. A complete report was submitted to Council.

Fire Department Report: Chief Garrett was not able to attend. Mr. Webster read the Fire Report.

Treasurer's Report: Secretary/Treasurer Paula Luca read the Treasurers Report. A Motion was made by Mr. Bollinger, to accept the Treasurers report, and pay the bills, Seconded by Mr. Rankin. All in Favor, No Opposed, Motion Carried.

Street Project: A Motion was made by Mr. Bollinger to accept the 2 Bid Packages that the Borough had received. One from Glenn Hawbacker, and one from Protech Asphalt. Seconded by Mrs. Bollinger. All in Favor, No Opposed, Motion Carried. Both Bids consist of three Options. Option 1: Walnut Street to include paving and 4 new catch basins. Option 2: Erie Street from Main to Walnut. Option 3: Oakhill Ext. Mr. Webster read both bids received, all three options for both.

A Motion was made by Mr. Bollinger to award the bid to Protech Asphalt for Option 1: Walnut Street to include paving and 4 new catch basins in the amount of \$70,605.25. Seconded by Mr. Ritter. A Roll Call Vote was taken:

A Motion was made by Mr. Webster, for the Borough of West Middlesex to purchase, in the amount of \$1.00, Parcel ID No: 75-888-093 from the Christian H. Buhl Legacy Trust. Seconded by Mrs. Bollinger. All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.

Resolution 3 of 2026: Emergency Petition in the Court of Common Pleas of Mercer County seeking Authority to Demolish an Unsafe Structure. Mr. Webster read the complete Resolution. A Motion was made by Mrs. Cristal Bollinger to accept Resolution 3 of 2026, Seconded by Mr. Keiuffer Ritter. All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.

Mayor's Convention: A Motion was made by Mr. Robert Rankin to approve Mayor Stacey Curry to attend the Mayor's Convention July 16-19, 2026 with cost of the convention, travel, and hotel to be paid by the Borough. Seconded by Mr. Keiuffer Ritter. All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.

Emergency Management: Mr. Tim Webster made a Motion to add Mrs. Cristal Bollinger to the Emergency Management Committee to work with Mr. Robert Rankin, Seconded by Mr. Keiuffer Ritter. All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.

Progressive Consultant: A Motion was made by Mr. Webster to accept the quote from Progressive Consultants to continue with Snyder Brothers for the cost of .47760, for a 36-month term Seconded by Mrs. Cristal Bollinger. All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.

Hiring of the Part Time Laborer Position: Two candidates applied for the position. Interviews were held today during the Executive Session. Mr. Webster stated that there are a couple of questions that still need to be answered. Mr. Ritter agreed, and he added, that he feels there are items that need to be clarified before a candidate is hired. Mr. Webster added that he will be on vacation next week, and he suggested that instead of adjourning this meeting that it be recessed until June 30th at 6:00. A Motion was made by Mr. Webster to Table the Hiring of the part time employee, Seconded by Mr. Rankin, All in Favor, No Opposed. Motion Carried.
