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## Sewer Billing Reminder

- **Due Date:** 25<sup>th</sup> of Each Month.
- **Late Fee:** 1% on account balances over 90 days past due
- **Payment Options:**
  - Local bank: First National Bank – West Middlesex Branch
  - Borough Office
  - Mail
  - Secure drop box at Borough Office
  - Direct deposit (set up at Borough Office)
- Residents with **past due sewer bills** are encouraged to contact the Borough office to arrange a **payment plan**.

**⚠ Please note:** If a payment plan is not set up, a **municipal lien may be placed on the property** until the account is paid in full. Setting up a plan now can help avoid this step! We are here to work with you!

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## **Reminder: Building Permits Are Required Before Starting Work**

Planning a construction or renovation project? Don't forget — **a building permit is required before starting any work** within the Borough. This includes projects like roofing, additions, decks, sheds, fences, major plumbing or electrical work, and more. Obtaining a permit ensures your project complies with safety codes and zoning regulations. Property Maintenance Inspections attempt to ensure that residential and commercial properties in the Borough are safe, secure, and sanitary by being maintained in accordance with the international Property Maintenance Code.
