May 14, 2019 Council Meeting: West Middlesex Borough Council Meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 14, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. The meetings are held at the municipal building located at 25 North Street.

Primary Election Day: May 21, 2019, polling is in the West Middlesex Municipal Building Hall.

Office Closed: The West Middlesex Borough Office will be closed Monday, May 27th in observance of Memorial Day.

Memorial Day Parade: The Memorial Day Parade will be on Monday, May 27th beginning at 10:00 a.m. It will move along Main Street from the post office to Haywood Street, turn left onto Haywood Street and into the cemetery. There will be a short ceremony in the cemetery immediately following the parade.

Grass: No person owning or occupying any property within the Borough shall permit any grass or weeds to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed ten (10) inches. Upon notification from the borough to cut any grass or weeds in violation of this ordinance, the owner or occupant of the premises will be given five (5) days to conform to these requirements. In case any person shall neglect, fail or refuse to comply with such notice within the period of time stated, the Borough authorities will remove such nuisance at a cost to the owner or occupant of \$50.00 per hour.

Message from the Fire Department: Grilling Safety: propane and charcoal grills should only be used outdoors; the grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches; keep children and pets away from the grill area; keep you grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill; and never leave your grill unattended.
