May Council Meeting: *SPECIAL MEETING AND RESCHEDULING OF MAY 2024 WORK SESSION:* The West Middlesex Borough Council will hold a **Special Meeting on Wednesday May 8, 2024 at 6:00 pm.** The purpose of the Special Meeting is to pass the Resolution: A Storm Water Management System and Maintenance Agreement on State Route #18 between the Borough of West Middlesex and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation. Immediately following the Special Meeting, Council will conduct its **Work Session** normally scheduled for Wednesday May 15th. The May 2024 **Council Meeting** is scheduled for **Tuesday May 21st at 6:30 pm.** The meetings are held at the West Middlesex Community Center Hall located at 25 North Street. ***All meetings are open to the public.*** If you have any questions, please feel free to call the Borough Office at (724) 528-9931.

Burning Hours: Burning hours are Tuesdays from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. **with a permit only!** Permits can be obtained for free at the Borough Office and are good for a six-month period.

Grass: No person owning or occupying any property within the Borough shall permit any grass or weeds to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed ten (10) inches. Upon notification from the borough to cut any grass or weeds in violation of this ordinance, the owner or occupant of the premises will be given five (5) days to conform to these requirements. In case any person shall neglect, fail or refuse to comply with such notice within the period of time stated, the Borough authorities will remove such nuisance at a cost to the owner or occupant of \$150.00 per hour.

Memorial Day Parade: The Memorial Day Parade will be Monday, May 27th at 10:00 a.m. The participants in the parade will form in front of the Post Office on Fair Street, at 9 a.m. The parade will begin at 10:00 a.m. The parade route will travel east on Main Street stopping for a brief ceremony at the Memorial located in front of the Gazebo. It will continue to Haywood Street entering the cemetery where another ceremony will take place. Local residents are encouraged to observe the parade.
