Pool Water: The West Middlesex Volunteer Fire Department is hauling pool water. If you are in need of water, please call (724) 528-2615.

Storm Sewers: Do not rake or blow your yard debris into the streets! The grass, leaves and other debris clog the storm sewers and create flooding problems!

Grass: No person owning or occupying any property within the Borough shall permit any grass or weeds to grow or remain upon such premises so as to exceed ten (10) inches. Upon notification from the borough to cut any grass or weeds in violation of this ordinance, the owner or occupant of the premises will be given five (5) days to conform to these requirements. In case any person shall neglect, fail or refuse to comply with such notice within the period of time stated, the Borough authorities will remove such nuisance at a cost to the owner or occupant of \$50.00 per hour.

Message from the Fire Department: Grilling Safety: propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors; the grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings and out from under eaves and overhanging branches; keep children and pets away from the grill area; keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grills and in trays below the grill; and never leave your grill unattended.
