Burning Hours: Tuesday from 5:00 to 8:00pm and Saturday from 8:00am to 12:00 pm. Residents may burn normal, household accumulations only. **The following items cannot be burned at any time: grass clippings, leaves, hay, bushes, roof shingles, upholstered furniture, clothing of any kind, diapers, mattresses, plastic or copper wires, paint, tires, aerosol cans, or any other material causing black smoke or obnoxious odors.**

A copy of the burning ordinance is available upon request.
