

## Borough of West Middlesex October 2019 Newsletter



*October 2019 Council Meeting:* The October 2019 Council Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. The October 2019 Work Session is scheduled for Wednesday, October 9<sup>th</sup> @ 6:00 p.m. The meetings are held at the municipal building located at 25 North Street, West Middlesex, Pa.

*Fall Leaf Pick-Up:* Tri-County has scheduled the fall Leaf Pick-Up Days for Friday, November 15<sup>th</sup> and Friday, December 13<sup>th</sup>. All leaves MUST BE BAGGED and lined up parallel to the street. **Please have your bagged leaves to the curb the evening before for early morning pick-up.** 

**Leaves: DO NOT** rake or blow your leaves into the streets or alleys. This creates a flooding problem with the leaves block the storm sewers! Please note, Borough Council has adopted an Ordinance that will result in a \$300 fine for blowing debris into the streets or alleys.

*Trick-or-Treat:* Trick-or-Treat will be on Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup> from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. in West Middlesex Borough. The Police Department and Fire Department will be available, but everyone should still be careful when crossing the streets.

**Veteran's Day Parade:** This year the Shenango Valley Veterans' Day Parade will be in the Borough of West Middlesex on Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. (line up at 6:00 p.m.) The parade route will be from the School Bus Garage to Erie Street. The VFW has scheduled Pancake Breakfasts from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> to raise funds to support the costs associated with this event.

**Light Up Night Parade: Saturday, December 7, 2019** @ **6:00 p.m.** (line up at 5:30 p.m.) There will be a parade on Main Street from the School Bus Garage to the Gazebo in Memorial Park, and then there will be time in the Community Room in the Borough Building with Santa Claus and refreshments.

**Burning Hours:** Burning hours are Tuesdays from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 1200 p.m. with a permit only! Permits can be obtained for free at the borough office and good for a six (6) month period of time. **Just a reminder, burning leaves in the borough is PROHIBITED!!!**
