The Borough Council would like to inform our Borough residents that at a special advertised Council Meeting that was held on October 27,2025, the Borough Council voted in favor to accept a proposal for Police coverage from the City of Farrell beginning January 1, 2026. This decision was not made lightly. Many things were taken into consideration with the main focus being: 1. The safety of our Residents, and Borough Business's.

2. The safety of our School Students, & 3. The Budget of the Borough. Although we do know you cannot put a price on safety, we would not be doing our Council obligation if we did not take into consideration the budget. Working with Farrell is not something that is new to the Borough. The Borough of West Middlesex was in the past, a part of Southwest Regional Police, consisting of Farrell, Wheatland, West Middlesex and Shenango Twp.
